Guest check in, freshen up for evening activities (Allow 1 hour)

Depart for dinner at the **Hammett House of Claremore**
Save room for dessert...you don't want to miss it! (Allow 1 to 1 ½ hours)



Depart for **Christmas Train at Dry Gulch USA**

Featured ride on an old fashioned Steam Train, The Christmas Train. You will experience the true meaning of Christmas amidst the sights and sounds of the season. The train ride itself features breathtaking artwork, live reenactments, a multimedia presentation, and an original music score. The Christmas Village features specialty shops, with concessions and dining options, with live entertainment. (this is an evening event only; allow 2 to 2 ½ hours)

Day 2

Depart for **Claremore Tour**

Visit the **J.M. Davis Arms & Historical Museum**

The world's largest privately owned gun collection with over 50,000 artifacts. The museum also exhibits the Claremore Wall of Fame, a dedication to the many Oklahoma legends that were born in Claremore. Legends like the Singing Rage, Miss Patti Page; Will Rogers, the Cherokee Kid; there would be no "Oklahoma!" without Lynn Riggs; an Astronaut, Stuart Roosa; the winner of the Bunion Derby; and the wife of business tycoon, Sam Walton, Mrs. Helen Walton. There is plenty more to see with a collection of John Wayne movie posters; a world class collection of steins, statuaries and World War II posters. (Allow 1 hour)

Next we are on to the **Will Rogers Memorial Museum**

Experience the life, legend, and humor of Oklahoma's Favorite son and an American Icon, Will Rogers. The museum features 12 magnificent interactive galleries; listen as he broadcasts hope in the midst of the Depression; enjoy one of his many featured films; and experience his life with an interpretative guide. (Allow 1 to 1 ½ hours)



Enjoy a guided, driving tour of Claremore; experience the old “**Bath Houses of Radium Town**”; the grand **Hotel Will Rogers**; and our beautiful historic downtown featuring antiques, unique, and collectibles. (Allow 45 minutes)

Lunch can be on your own at one of the many great diners and cafes in downtown, such as the Pink House, Belvidere’s Tea Room, Dot’s Café or Boom A-Rang Diner. (Allow 2 hours)

Experience the legendary **Lynn Riggs Memorial and Belvidere Mansion** (1 block from each other, generally groups visit each while in the vicinity). Lynn Riggs, play write who wrote Green Grows the Lilac, later became Rogers and Hammerstein’s “**Oklahoma!**”. The memorial houses the original *Surrey with a Fringe on Top*, and memorabilia from the movie. The Belvidere is a Victorian Mansion decorated for Christmas, with plenty of special gift ideas and stunning, period decorations. (Allow 1 hour)



Depart for the hotel, freshen up before evening events (Allow 1 hour)

Dinner at the **Route 66 Nut House**

Enjoy this log cabin, also decorated for the holidays, with plenty of treats to taste, special gift selections, homemade goodies, souvenirs, and a wonderful hot meal to keep you warm for the light displays. (Allow 1 ½ hours)

All aboard for the **Christmas light tour of Rhema Bible College** in Broken Arrow. You do not want to miss this unbelievable scene of holiday spirit, with more than 100,000 lights! There are more great light displays as we drive through Tulsa, Catoosa and Claremore. Along the way we will find hot chocolate and more shopping if desired. (Allow 2 hours)
