Arrive at the **Claremore Museum of History and Visitor's Center**—where Claremore's legends, who made Oklahoma famous in the music, theatre and arts, are honored. Experience the world class exhibits of Patti Page, Andy Payne, Will Rogers, and Lynn Riggs, who wrote the Green Grow the Lilacs, a play that would become the basis for the musical and movie, "Oklahoma!" (allow 1 hour)

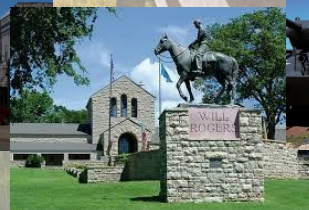
**The Belvidere Mansion**, a historic Victorian Mansion, built in 1907 and was the center of town with balls, banquets, and hotel rooms. Self-guided tours are available during open hours. **The Pink House**, located inside the mansion, is a wonderful tea room with a delicious menu served daily. Group reservations must be made in advance. \*\*the mansion is 3-stories and does not have an elevator -Pink House is located on the first floor\*\*

Enjoy shopping just blocks from the Belvidere with boutiques, antiques, and unique merchants all in three blocks. Great lunch options on your own all in the **Lilac District**.

Oklahoma's favorite son, Will Rogers, called Claremore home and we honor his life at the **Will Rogers Memorial Museum** through numerous exhibits, artifacts, movies, and events at the museum every day. Join "Will Rogers" for a tour, wit, and rope tricks during your groups visit. (allow 1.5 to 2 hours)

**J.M. Davis Arms and Historical Museum** is the world's largest privately-owned gun collection with over 50,000 artifacts including steins, statuary, World War I posters and so much more. You can see where the grand collection began in the lobby of the Mason Hotel inside the museum. Be sure to grab a group photo with the tank outside, weather permitting of course. (allow 1 hour)
