

## ROUTE 66 ROADTRIP FROM CHELSEA TO CLAREMORE

Our first location on Route 66 is Chelsea where the first Sears and Roebuck House, west of the Mississippi was delivered by train. You can stop at the **Pryor Creek Bridge Truss** located on the original 66 highway and see a few historic murals in the hometown of Oklahoma's first non-commercial oil well (*allow 30 minutes*).



Next, onward to Foyil to see **Ed Galloway's Totem Pole Park**, a monument to the American Indian, slightly off Historic 66 (*allow 30 minutes*).

**J.M. Davis Arms & Historical Museum** provides a guided tour of the world's largest, privately owned gun collection. The museum hosts over 50,000 artifacts including a world class stein collection, statuary collection, World War I posters, and much, much more (*allow 1 hour*).

**Will Rogers Memorial Museum** provides an entire experience with a guided tour by an authentic Will Rogers re-enactor. Oklahoma's favorite son called Claremore home and the Memorial hosts 12 galleries of artifacts, memorabilia, Will's saddle collection, photographs and manuscripts depicting careers as a trick roper, Vaudeville & Ziegfeld Follies performer, movie star, radio commentator, syndicated newspaper columnist, humorist, and proud citizen of the Cherokee Nation (*allow 1.5 hours*).

**Claremore Museum of History** is the newest addition to Claremore's growing Museum Coalition. It showcases Claremore's unique history, from radium baths to playwright, Lynn Riggs. Enjoy artifacts from the musical Oklahoma! Including the original "surrey with the fringe on top". Also featured is memorabilia from astronaut Stuart Roosa and "the Singin' Rage" Miss Patti Page (*allow 1 hour*).

**The Blue Whale of Catoosa** has become one of the most iconic stops along Historic Route 66. This notorious attraction was built in the early 1970's and has become an excellent stop to take pictures and feel like a kid again (*allow 30 minutes*).
